### Pastor's paragraphs

Essayist and poet Joseph Addison (1672-1719) said: "Faith is kept alive in us, and gathers strength, more from practice than from speculations." (Bits & Pieces, July 2008)

We talk a lot about faith. We know that the Bible describes it in Hebrews 11 as believing without seeing. We know too, that Jesus said that genuine faith, even the size of a mustard seed, can move mountains. We even know that without faith, it is impossible to please God.
